Holiness grows when you:

I. Know Your Redemption. v. 18 “Knowing that you were redeemed...”

A. Redemption Defined: (straight from the vocabulary of the ancient slave market)

- to liberate (i.e. - slaves, captives, prisoners) by payment of a ransom
- to cause to be released to one's self by payment of a price

B. Redemption Announces:

1. Complete Liberty - v. 18 “from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers

From Sin's Guilt - Ephesians 1:7

From Sin's Authority - Romans 6

From Law's Futility - v. 18; Galatians 3:12-14

2. Committed Loyalty -

1 Peter 2:9 - “His own special people”

1 Corinthians 7:22-24, 1 Corinthians 6:19-20, Titus 2:11-14

II. Know the Price of Your Redemption. v. 19 “but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.”

A. Beyond Measure - *Price is measured by the “Buyers” pleasure in what he spends.*

B. The Preciousness of the Price paid for us, reveals:

A. Our Priceless **Gift** from God. v. 18 “not with corruptible things like silver or gold”

B. Our Personal **Value** to God. v. 19 “but with the precious blood of Christ”

*Our Value is all of God and is Revealed in both
Original Design (the image of God) & Redemption Price (the Image of God)*

1 Corinthians 7:22-24; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; Titus 2:14

Walking worthy of the Calling of our Redemption

Revelation 5:8-10

1 Peter 1:13-21

13 Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; 14 as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance; 15 but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, 16 because it is written, “Be holy, for I am holy.”

17 And if you call on the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one’s work, conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay here in fear; 18 knowing that you were redeemed not with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot. 20 He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you 21 who through Him believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.
